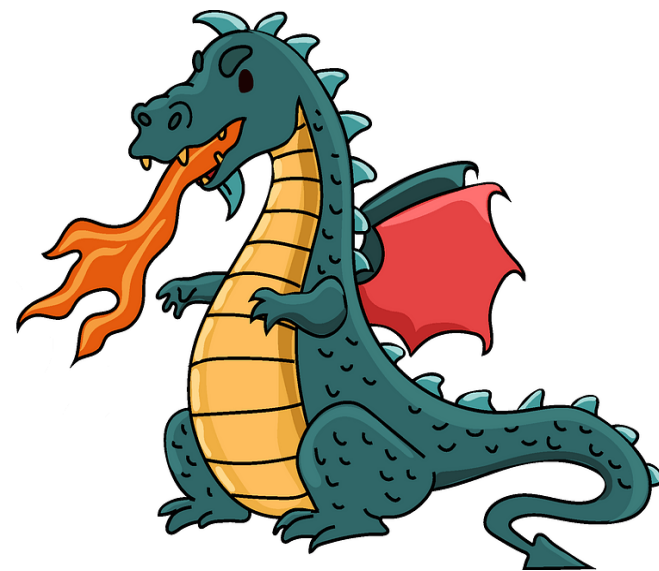
Rise of the Earth Dragon*
