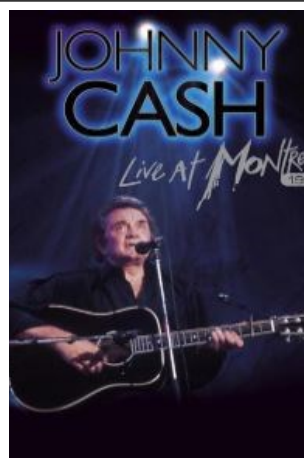


An exploration of Native American-based mascots, especially the Washington Redskins, and their impact on real-life attitudes, issues, and policies.

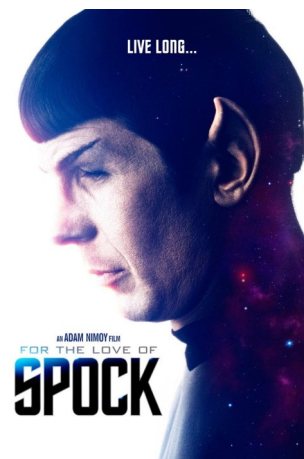
